Along with your senior portrait, in the Senior Section of the yearbook, you will be able to personalize with a SENIOR QUOTE and informal PHOTOGRAPHS of your choice. This is a unique opportunity to express yourself during your final year at MPI. Here is what to do:

1. Get Your Senior Quote Done!

Your senior quote can contain up to 400 characters, which include letters, numbers, punctuations, and spaces. This year there will be no abbreviations of words except names of family and friends. Everything must be completely written out (i.e., Thank you can be Thanks but not 10Q, Thanx etc). Please do not use foreign languages. While we respect other languages, our inability to translate all the languages prevents us from conducting a proper content check. Your quote will appear as it is typed (i.e., if it is all in caps, it will be printed that way.) Please do not stylize text. Keep it formal and simple.

The yearbook staff maintains its authority and responsibility for the book's content. All quotes will be edited for content. Those quotes failing to meet the standards we have set WILL NOT BE PRINTED. Initials, which are believed to be in poor taste, will be edited. Thank you for your understanding.

If you choose NOT to have a senior quote in the yearbook, please return this form with your name on the lines provided to verify spelling. Please write legibly.

2. Turn in your Senior Candid Photos!

The yearbook senior section will be more personalized this year. For that reason we need to collect a few things from you. We hope you can gather these things on time and have them ready by our deadline. We cannot accept any late items.

1. Please submit one (1) baby picture of yourself;

2. Please submit two (2) candid pictures of you with your family or friends.

Photo Prints: Label the backs with your first and last name. (We will scan them in and return them to you when we are finished.)

Digital photos: Burn the photos to a CD with your name printed on the CD.

JPEG only, 300 dpi, no larger than 4" x 6", 1-4 mg is about the size the file should be.

This is a total of three (3) pictures. No late pictures will be accepted after the deadline. Please remember that if the pictures do not adhere with MPI standards they will not be in the yearbook.

PLEASE PLACE YOUR PHOTOS IN AN ENVELOPE WITH YOUR FIRST AND LAST NAME AND PHONE NUMBER ON IT. Bring it to the yearbook office at the Multi Media Zone, WTP by DEADLINE: Friday, September 12, 2008!
